



## Shore Lines ALERTS November 9, 2011



- **From the Department of Transportation** in response to inquiries about the undermining of Route 9P north of Brown's Beach: "The work is part of a contract to make road repairs following Hurricane Irene and Tropical Storm Lee. At this location, we are stabilizing soil on the slope that supports Route 9P. For safety, we have instituted a one-way alternating traffic pattern between County Route 108, Plains Road, to County Route 76, Lake Road. I'm told that work is expected to be completed this weekend, so things should be back to normal by Monday."
- **Boats and docks** stored on the right-of-way are considered a hazard and are illegal. Fixed objects present safety issues for vehicles, including snowplows.
- **DO NOT** put your leaves and lawn debris in roadside culverts.
